## General Hazards

Common kinds of danger in a warehouse environment are slips, trips and falls. These accidents are often caused when staff lose their balance or stumble over an item that has not been put away properly. Removing or placing stuff from storage can result in a slip or fumble, potentially causing both item and employee to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when staff are moving supplies on different kinds of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling items. This is usually caused by failure to properly stack stuff on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries due to improper lifting techniques are one more common danger.

Warehouse equipment carries inherent hazards. Accidents or injuries can be caused by hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors if they are not operated correctly. Warehouse tools, like pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, need to be used carefully in loading, packing and unpacking.

Dangerous substances, flammable or combustible materials could pose danger while being stored in a warehouse. Employees need to know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards when working around hazardous materials.
