Cambridge Loader Training - What Are Included In A Loader Training Course? - Anyone who wants to operate a forklift must take a Loader Training program to become a certified forklift truck operator. There are various ways to obtain forklift training. Programs are provided through workforce training agencies, company forklift certification programs, and approved on line and video courses. The price can be minimal (or without charge) when offered by occupational safety officers on job sites or through employment agencies.

Lift truck operators have to be 18 years of age or over, in nearly all nations. Local industry bodies approve Loader Training courses and require operators to obtain a certificate before operating this type of heavy machines. A certificate is valid for four years in most areas. Businesses that hire workers to drive forklift trucks can face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators can cause property damage and serious injury due to improper use of the machinery. Training includes the proper loading and driving methods. Employees should pass a written exam to be able to be certified. A business would normally assign a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new workers. A licensed supervisor should have extensive training in lift truck safety and be trained as a trainer.
